- Linux Ubuntu 12.10 (up-to-date, suitable for development)
- getting source files
 - \$ git clone git://anongit.freedesktop.org/libreoffice/core #
- getting needed packages for development
 - sudo apt-get build-dep libreoffice
- building source files (~5hours at Lenovo T400)
 - ./autogen.sh
 - make
 - make dev-install

Solution

- searching source files
 - git grep FEAT_FSYS_DOUBLESPEED
- remove all occurences in source files
