



Building LibreOffice on Linux

Build dependencies

In general, the easiest way to build LibreOffice is on Linux.

First you need to install the build dependencies:

```
On Debian/Ubuntu: sudo apt-get build-dep libreoffice
On OpenSUSE 11.4+: sudo zypper si -d libreoffice
On Fedora 15+ & derivatives: sudo yum-builddep libreoffice
```

Note that these commands might not install everything that is necessal pause they use the distro's package as a source used for building it. For more details or information for other distros such see the age on all depends






