

The bug

 When repositioning and/or changing the frame of the subview displayed on top of the blur, the close button doesn't move along with it.



Solutions

- 1) Override method given as default by inheritance from UIView
 (void) setFrame:(CGRect)frame
- 2) Add new public method

 (void) resizeSubview:(int)h andWith:(int)w
 that would only change the size of the subview
 along with the close button

Pros and cons

- setFrame
- + more standard(-ish)
- + more understandable
- doesn't automatically align the subview to middle

- resizeSubview
- + automatic alignment of the subview
- + more appropriate for some specific subviews
- not obvious until searched for in the documentation
