




How it works





The bug

 When repositioning and/or changing the frame of the subview displayed on top of the blur, the close button doesn't move along with it.



My solution

2) Add new public method
 - (void) moveCloseButton:(CGPoint)point
 changes the position of the close button in order
 to have it in the top left corner

Pros and cons

- moveCloseButton
- + fast and easy to use when implementing complex animations
- + more appropriate for some specific subviews
- not obvious until searched for in the documentation


